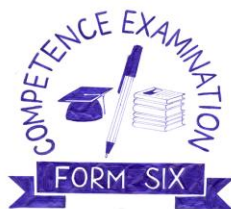

 - a) Calculate the area of the western of 800E in square kilometer
 - b) Identify the types of vegetation cover with vivid examples from the map.
 - c) With evidence from the map, identify two (02) endogenic and exogenic activities which may be depicted respectively.
 - d) With vivid examples from the map, identify three (03) social amenities that may be present from the map.
 - e) From the map identify two types of rocks that might exist with the evidence from the map.
 - f) Using the mapped area identify three determinants of climate and suggest about the climate of the area.

 - a) What type of survey is used to make contours?
 - b) What is the major equipment's used in the type of survey mentioned in (a)? three (3) equipments (use diagrams)
