1. Johansen and Cruz were industrial workers who participated to sign people's charter in 1838 in order to fight against workers' mistreatment. Examine six (6) demands which were found in the document.
2. Mr. Jumanne told the people of Mvoutessi that "The rise of dictatorship in Italy could not be achieved without the personal efforts of Benito Andrea Mussolini." Assess the validity of this statement (provide six points)
3. The emergence of new nation of Germany in 1871 was not "a one night process." This statement was said by Mr. Mloka the historian expert of Kilosa district. Analyze how the European societies were affected by that process (provide six points).
4. Karl Marx and Fredrick Angels brought the idea of scientific socialism in both West and Eastern Europe. Unfortunately the idea failed to be implemented in many parts of Western Europe. Appraise six (6) reasons for their failure.
5. Japan and USA fought in opposite syndicates during the Second World War, but after the war USA became the main creditor to rescue Japanese economy. Analyze six (6) impacts of such contradictory role of USA.
6. Mr. Seleman participated in the Arab-Jewish wars between 1950's on the side of Arabs. He was narrating to students on how the wars affected people at that time. Examine six (6) points he explained.
7. Most of the African countries are still in extreme poverty in spite of different interventions carried out previously. Why do you think South-South dialogue could not stand as the permanent solution to this tragedy? Provide six (6) points).
