 - (ii) When the lower lip and the upper teeth touch each other _____
 - (iii) When the tongue touches the upper teeth ridge _____
 - (iv) When the tongue touches soft palate _____
 - (vi) When the tongue touches hard palate and teeth ridge _____
3. (a) Your friend has come to school lately and missed the session about bound morphemes. You have been asked to identify inflectional morphemes for him in each of the given sentences. Then state the word class of the words containing inflectional morphemes.
 - (i) Khadija's phone is very attractive
 - (ii) He is expected to do well.
 - (iii) Simba and Luza are my friends.
 - (iv) Kabezi is driving his car.
 - (v) Often, Tanasha speaks clearly.
