1. Muslims in your locality have been confused by Cadian scholar who taught them that there will be the coming Prophet after Prophet Muhammad (s.a.w). Assist your fellows by giving four (4) arguments against Cadian teachings.
2. Ally refused to deposit his money to banks which are offering interest due to its bad effects. Briefly explain five (5) factors which influenced his decision.
3. Sara and Maimuna are class mates who claimed that they are not going to get married because they don't see importance of marriage and family. Clear their misconception by showing them five (5) motives of marriage in Islam.
4. Islam as a complete system of life has its political system which differentiates it from Western political system. Briefly analyze four (4) features from Islam which bring about this differences.
5. Belief in hereafter is one of the universal contradictions in the hands of materialists as to them "There is no possibility of giving life to a decomposed body and dry bone." Use your understanding to prove before them the inevitability. (Five (5) points).
6. "And (remember) when you said "O Moses" we shall never believe you till we see Allah plainly (2:55)." With reference to this contention, educate non-believers about their stand through History of human being. (Five (5) points)
