5. In one live streaming broadcast a young Muslim musician Lady hated Islamic law of inheritance saying it insults and subjugates the right of some members of the family. In five statements, display the wisdom behind the Islamic law of inheritance to create awareness to the community.
6. By giving five (5) points elaborate the purpose of Islamic Shariah in real life.
