4. In this world there are two kinds of laws, man made law and Allah’s law. Show five (5) main differences of these laws.
5. The rate of divorce in our community is too high nowadays. Analyse three (3) causes and suggest two solutions.
6. Our community is not believing in Qadar. Show five (5) indicators which prove that they are not believers in this pillar of faith.
